

Matt 28: 1 In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre (the grave of Jesus).

John 3:36 He that **believeth** on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that **believeth NOT** the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

Romans 10: 9 That if thou shalt confess (or acknowledge) with thy mouth the **Lord** Jesus, and shalt **believe** in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, **thou shalt be saved**.

Romans 10:10 For WITH **the heart** man *believeth UNTO righteousness*; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Romans 4: 20 He staggered not at the promise of God **through unbelief**; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; (Abraham did not withdraw from God's promise or hesitate to believe God's Word)

4: 21 And being **fully persuaded** that, what he had promised (announced) he was able also to perform.

4: 22 And therefore (because he was fully persuaded) it was **imputed** to him for righteousness.

Heb 11: 6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him

Ro 4: 23 Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was **imputed** to him;

24 But for us also, to whom it **shall be imputed**, IF WE BELIEVE on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead;

25 Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification.

Galatians 3: 6 Even as Abraham believed God, and it (his faith) was accounted (inventoried) to him for righteousness.

7 Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, **the same** are the children of Abraham.

8 And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen **through faith**, *preached before* the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed.

9 So then **they which be of faith** are blessed with faithful Abraham.

Mt 11:28 Come unto me (through faith) all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Romans 10:10 For WITH **the heart** man *believeth unto righteousness*; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Isa 1:18 Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.

Romans 10: 11 For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed (caused to blush).

John 10:24 Then came the Jews round about him, and said unto him, How long dost thou make us to doubt? If thou be the Christ, **tell us plainly**.

1John 5:1 Whosoever believeth that Jesus is *the Christ* is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat (God) loveth him also that is begotten of him (Jesus).

Romans 3:23 For all (you and I) have sinned, and (because of our sin – you and I have) come (fallen) short of the glory of God (our sins have caused us to **miss the mark**)

Mt 7:3 And why beholdest thou the mote (small spec) that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam (big branch) that is in thine own eye?

4 Or how wilt thou say to thy brother, Let me pull out the mote out of thine eye; and, behold, a beam is in thine own eye?

5 **Thou hypocrite**, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

Ecclesiastes 7:20 For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

Luke 5:31 And Jesus answering said unto them, They that are whole need not a physician; but they that are sick.

Ps 51:12 Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit.
